



Two Nordic Combined National Team Athletes to Compete for Canada 2019-2020

Calgary, Alberta, October 24, 2019 – Nordic Combined Ski Canada (“NCSC”) is please to announce that former Canadian Olympian women’s ski jumper, Taylor Henrich has recently joined our Nordic Combined National Team and will be competing internationally this season. Taylor, along with current National Team member, Nathaniel Mah, will proudly represent Canada at competitions scheduled in the United States and Europe as they continue towards the next Olympic Games.

Taylor Henrich currently resides and trains in Vancouver, B.C. and began her career in ski jumping in Calgary, Alberta. She competed in the Olympic games in Sochi and PyeongChang and achieved two World Cup bronze medal podium finishes. Taylor’s ski jumping strength strongly complements her Nordic skiing as she demonstrated in last season’s podium finishes in the first women’s North American Continental Cup event held in Park City, Utah. We wish Taylor every success as she is Canada’s first women’s National Team Nordic Combined Athlete and will be a fierce competitor in the developing sport of women’s Nordic Combined.

Nathaniel Mah currently resides in Canmore, Alberta and began his career in Nordic Combined at the age 6 in Calgary. He has tremendous passion for Nordic Combined and this summer, finished second in the U.S. Nationals open event and 27th at the summer Grand Prix in Planica, Slovenia. Nathaniel has also competed at numerous Continental Cup and World Cup events with several finishes in the top 30. He currently trains in Cross Country Skiing with the Alberta World Cup Academy and in Slovenia for ski jumping.

Canada first participated in the sport of Nordic Combined at the Olympic games in 1928. Today we have grass roots Nordic Combined developments programs occurring in both the Whistler/Squamish, B.C. and also in the Calgary/Bow Valley/Red Deer, Alberta corridors from which we hope to invigorate many more young Canadian athletes to pursue their dreams in this exciting Olympic sport.
